The successful applicant will possess a proven track record on gender issues preferably relating to disadvantaged groups, significant experience working in inclusive development and strong qualitative skills to contribute to health and development research and/or policy analysis.

In return they will have the ability to build on their established work in the area of Disability Inclusion and/or gender studies in low and middle-income countries and to play a lead/ co-lead role in further developing the technical and research programs of the Nossal.
