PROCESS	KEY DATES	
Online application	27 February - 2 April	<p>Candidates must submit an online application prior to the closing date to be considered for a graduate position.</p> <p>The application includes education, academic results, achievements, extracurricular activities, and written questions.</p> <p>The application form must be completed in full and a resume, academic transcript, and proof of residency must also be attached.</p> <p>To be eligible to progress to the next stage, minimum requirements must also be met:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GPA credit average of 65 or above • Graduate from an undergraduate degree (minimum of 3 years) in 2017, 2016, or 2015 • Have ongoing work rights in Australia at the time of application
Online testing	5 April - 9 April	<p>On completion of the online application stage, successful candidates will be asked to complete online testing in order to demonstrate verbal, numerical, and logical reasoning skills.</p> <p>The assessment, Talent Q will take approximately 20 minutes to complete.</p>
Video interview	12 April - 18 April	<p>On completion of the online testing stage, successful candidates will be invited to participate in an online video interview via the Vieple system. The Vieple system works similarly to Skype, except that the interview is not live.</p> <p>When candidates initially log in to the system, they will have the opportunity to familiarise themselves with the system. Once the practice question has been completed, candidates will complete the video interview.</p> <p>Candidates will answer a series of pre-recorded interview questions that will appear on-screen.</p>
Assessment centre	1 May	<p>On completion of the video interview stage, successful candidates will be invited to attend an assessment centre at the Parkville campus. Travel to the assessment centre will be at the candidate's expense.</p> <p>The assessment centre will be the first opportunity for candidates to meet the team. On the day, candidates can deepen their understanding of what it's really like to work at the University of Melbourne and begin a career that makes a world of difference.</p> <p>During the assessment centre, candidates will be asked to participate in a variety of tasks ranging from partner work and group work to individual presentations, giving them the opportunity to showcase who they really are.</p>
Interviews	2 May - 5 May	<p>In the final stage of the recruitment process, candidates will be invited to participate in face-to-face interviews.</p>
Offers	Mid May	<p>Written offers will be made to successful candidates in mid May.</p>
