You will utilise your relevant experience and skills to deliver the key responsibilities such as the following of the position:

- Communicate to senior government officials the impacts of malaria and related interventions that are funded by Australia either bilaterally or multilaterally
- Collate and write situational awareness analyses on malaria in Australia
- Manage media campaigns and generate media opportunities that promote specific objectives
